3) Discussion/Voting: **PMGA Confirmation of Local Rules**

- a. **Bunkers – Lift smooth and place** (not a drop) for areas disturbed by other golfers only. For other bunker lie conditions (e.g. “fried eggs”) ball played as lies unless the area has also been disturbed by another golfer. **Committee voice vote in favor, approved 5-0**
- b. **Conceded Putts:** Putts of **24” or less** can be conceded by an opponent (Match Play/Match Play & Stroke Play Combination Play) or by consensus of the playing group (Stroke Play). Putts of 24” or less are not deemed to be automatically conceded, nor are putts of over 24” allowed to be conceded in Stroke Play. **Committee voice vote in favor, approved 5-0**

4) Discussion/Voting: **PMGA Competition**

- a. **Senior Play:** Senior golfers *of the age of 70 or older* may play from the White tees in all PMGA events *at their option*. In this case, the golfer must notify the pro shop at the time they sign up for the tournament and must play with their course handicap from the white tees **Committee voice vote in favor, approved 5-0**
- b. **President’s Cup Match Play:** President’s Cup match play events to be played at 100% handicap as opposed to 80% for all other Sunday net events **Committee voice vote in favor, approved 3 to 1 with 1 abstention.**

- c. **Monday Night PMGA League:** Monday night match play to be played at 100% handicap as opposed to 80%. **Committee voice vote in favor, approved 2 to 1 with 2 abstentions**

5) Discussion/Voting: **PMGA Schedule**

- a. **Skins Games and Shootout:** Motion to reinstate Gross and Net skins games and Top 10 Shootout **Committee voice vote in favor, approved 5-0**

Action: Pro Shop to provide revised schedule.

- b. There was a lengthy discussion on how to fund the current deficit within the Skins end of season pools due to the Pro Shop not allocating a percentage of proceeds to date as customary in prior seasons.

Motions were on the table to allocate a flat \$20 per week from each pool for the remainder of the year as the sole funding source for the Skins games as well as a percentages of proceeds method. The issues discussed revolved around avoiding the “cross pollenating” of each pool to the other.

No agreement was reached, and the item was tabled

It was agreed that the pro shop should start allocating for the Skins games during the current week (with no agreement as to method).
